Our Legacy

Ever since its inception in the year 1845 by the then Maharaja of Eerst while Cochin state Rama Varma, SRV has been acclaimed as one of the oldest schools in the state of Kerala and still continues to carry its royal legacy. The school that first initiated as a single teacher elementary school by the name Cochin Raja's School, was later renamed as HH The Rajas School in 1865. In 1868, the first batch of SRV students gave the Matriculation exam from Madras University victoriously and there has been no turning back ever since. On July 26th 1870 the new school building was inaugurated and by 1875 the school was upgraded as a second grade college affiliated to the Madras University. The school celebrated its Golden Jubilee in the year 1925 and the same year ascended as First Grade College by the name Maharajas College.

With time, the count of students and teachers multiplied many fold and it became necessary to separate the school section from the college campus. Thus, in 1934, in the land given by the Kaaraykat family, the current school campus began to function. In 1995, the school marked its 150th anniversary and celebrated this great achievement with great pomp and splendour. The Vocational Higher Secondary section began functioning in 1989 and in 2000 the Higher Secondary department. This pioneer temple of learning has paved the way for the growth of many eminent personalities who have been recognised at national, international and state levels.
